<p>Role Overview:</p> <p>The Player Development Coordinator is responsible for developing a structured Athlete Development Program (ADP) that aligns skill development with the Netball Development Framework allowing a natural progression pathway from Go to Intermediate.</p> <p>The Player Development Coordinator will work with coaches to identify players to trial for Academy and State Teams to represent Tango in in the coaching structure to develop coaches to ensure compliance with Netball SA coaching accreditation standards, club requirements and to consistently introduce the Athlete Development Program. The Development Coordinator will liaise with personnel inside and outside the club to identify player and coach development opportunities.</p>		
<p>Principal Accountabilities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Develop and Manage the Athlete Development Program (ADP) in accordance with club requirements. 2. Document the ADP in liaison with club personnel for Management Committee approval. 3. Liaise with all TNC coaches and the Match Committee, as required, to integrate the ADP across all playing age groups. 4. Identify and attract new playing talent to TNC as necessary. 		

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5. Monitor the performance of club athletes at all levels of competition to assess potential and personnel development opportunities. i.e. Carnival, Academy and State.
6. Liaise with relevant persons outside the club for input into athlete development at the club, as required.
7. Coordinate/Deliver specialist coaching sessions
8. Prepare a coaches development plan which meets accreditation requirements for Netball SA.
9. Review coaching manuals or other documents as required as references to assist coaches with standards and the application of coaching skills in accordance with club requirements.
10. Monitor coaching performance and provide feedback to individual coaches, as required.
11. Liaise with the Match Committee about the appointment of coaches.
12. Represent the club at coach development opportunities/meetings managed by external agencies relevant to the conduct of club business, as required.
13. Attend training nights and game days as required

Position Summary:

The Player Development Coordinator is responsible for managing the ADP and overseeing player development across teams playing in competitions from Go to Intermediate age groups. Strong communications is an important part of the role to ensure the ADP is integrated with strategies to support athlete development throughout the identified age groups. The Player Development Coordinator provides a central reference for contact regarding performance standards and athlete development opportunities through liaison with coaches and other personnel. The position is required to monitor the performance of athletes and provide advice where required to individual athletes, teams, the Coach Development Coordinator and Club Coach about personnel development opportunities to athletes in transition from intermediate to senior levels of competition. The Player Development Coordinator works closely with the Coaches and President, and provides monthly reports to the Management Committee.
